# BAYLOR COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

Located in the metropolitan hub of Houston Texas right next to the Texas Medical Center, Baylor is an exciting place of learning. They have been ranked by U.S. News as 12<sup>th</sup> in Primary Care and 21<sup>st</sup> in research. The proximity to the Texas Medical Center provides students with the resources of the world's largest medical complex. The college currently has about 750 students total.

Baylor students have access to their 8 educational affiliates including the Baylor St. Luke's medical center. Affiliate hospitals include: MD Anderson Cancer Center, Texas Children's, Children's Hospital of San Antonio, Harris Health, Menninger, Michael E. DeBakey Veterans Affairs Medical Center, TIRR Memorial Hermann. Baylor students go into a variety of specialties, however the school is well known for pediatrics. Baylor has been ranked as 9<sup>th</sup> in the nation for pediatrics specialties.

BCM offers a several academic programs including four dual degree programs in association with other local institutions.

M.D./ J.D. – A six year program working in conjunction with the University of Houston Law Center.

M.D./ M.P.H. – A five year program working with the University of Texas School of Public Health.

M.D./ M.B.A – A five year program working with Rice University's Jones Graduate School of Business.

M.D./ P.H.D. – An intensive program that allows students to gain more clinical research experience while earning their M.D.

On top of their many excellent programs Baylor is also when of the country's least expensive medical schools with tuition and fees coming in at about \$30,000 per year.
